GENERAL OVERVIEW

The seminar will be the first of its kind on the territory of Eastern Europe that will deal with questions of the role of Churches and Religions in the direction of ecologically acceptable energy supply and sustainable development in Ukraine in a tight collaboration with local and central authorities, scientific institutions, educational establishments and the public.

The program of the workshop also foresees familiarization with the cities of Uzhhorod and Mukachevo, excursions to museums and castles.

The languages of the workshop are Ukrainian, German and English.

Materials that will meet the following criteria will be accepted: wordage – less than 7 pages, written in Ukrainian or English, typed in Word.rtf text processor (orientation – Portrait; font - Times New Roman; font size – 12; interval – 1,5; top and left margin – 30, bottom – 20, right – 10 mm).

The materials are to be submitted via e-mail as attached file in *.rtf format or in text format in the body of the letter.

The materials have to contain the full title (in upper case), the surname(s) and initials of the author(s) (in bold type, underlining the surname of the speaker, with right alignment), name of the establishment represented, city and (preferably) e-mail of the author, that will present the work on the seminar. It is preferable not to use dashed images and coloured graphs.

The authors take full responsibly on the content and reliability of the presented material.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse materials that do not meet these criteria, their subjects are not related to the topic of the workshop, or they are submitted after **January 31, 2010**.
